1. Signed Application (**original signature**) with all requested information (including financial aid information)
2. Essay addressing the three stated questions
3. Official Copy of high school or college transcript in a sealed envelope
4. Letter of acceptance – first time and transfer college students
5. Two **current** letters of recommendations written to the KAAS from **nonrelatives**. One Pastor or Church Official and the second from a mentor, teacher, counselor, friend, etc. Recommendations must be signed.

Application must be postmarked by July 31, 2024. INCOMPLETE and LATE applications will not be considered.

FYI: Applications will be processed during the months of September and October. Checks will be distributed during the month of November. Applicants not receiving a scholarship will be notified at the same time as the awardees.
